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The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #11-0637, which is for the purpose of increasing the maximum aggregate principal amount of revenue obligations that may be issued by the City under Ordinance 07-420. The proposed legislation will increase the maximum principal amount of revenue bonds to be issued for the City's Water Utility System from \$585,000,000 to \$1,017,000,000. This increase in will permit the funding of new Capital Improvement Program Projects for Water Utility through FY 2016. Additionally, the funds issued under this authorization will be used on improvements for water treatment and water distribution projects that are already in the City's CIP.
