2 3 4	FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Works to provide a specified person with a copy of a certain water or wastewater bill upon request and submission of specified documentation.

10	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the		
11	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14	Subtitle 2. Bills		
15	§ 2-1. Bills.		
16	(a) Finance to collect.		
17	The bills for water used or work done by the Department of Public Works shall be		
18	collected by the Department of Finance.

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1	(b) When due.			
2 3	Unless abated under this subtitle, all bills therefor shall be paid within 20 days after they have been issued.			
4	(c) Cut-off on default.			
5 6	Subject to the requirements of this article, on default in payment for bills issued under this section, the Department of Public Works may cut off the supply.			
7	(d) Copy of bill to tenant-water-utility customer.			
8 9	(1) Any landlord that requires a residential tenant to pay for the costs of water or wastewater services shall:			
10 11	(I) [(1)] include that requirement in a written lease, as provided in City Code Article 13, § 7-3(a-1); and			
12	(II) [(2)] either:			
13 14	(A) [(i)] timely provide the tenant with a copy of the water or wastewater bill; or			
15 16	(B) [(ii)] timely notify the Department that a copy of the bill should be sent to the tenant.			
17 18	(2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TIMELY PROVIDE A COPY OF A WATER OR WASTEWATER BILL TO A TENANT-WATER-UTILITY CUSTOMER WHO:			
19 20	(I) REQUESTS A COPY OF A WATER OR WASTEWATER BILL ISSUED DURING A TIME PERIOD THE TENANT WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE BILL; AND			
21 22 23 24	(II) PROVIDES THE DEPARTMENT WITH A COPY OF A WRITTEN LEASE FOR THE PROPERTY, AS PROVIDED IN CITY CODE ARTICLE 13, § 7–3(A–1), THAT INCLUDES A REQUIREMENT THAT THE TENANT PAY FOR THE COSTS OF WATER OR WASTEWATER SERVICES.			
25 26	(I) SUBMITS, EITHER IN PERSON OR VIA ELECTRONIC MEANS, A SIGNED COPY OF THE DEPARTMENT'S WATER BILL REQUEST FORM; OR			

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1	(II) DOES NOT SUBMIT A COPY OF THE WATER BILL REQUEST FORM, BUT		
2	PROVIDES, EITHER IN PERSON OR VIA ELECTRONIC MEANS, 1 OF THE		
3	FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS, WHICH SHALL BE ADDRESSED TO THE INDIVIDUA		
4	AT THE PROPERTY FOR WHICH THEY ARE REQUESTING A COPY OF THE		
5	WATER BILL:		
6	(A) A VALID GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION CARD;		
7	(B) A VOTER REGISTRATION CARD;		
8	(C) 2 PIECES OF MAIL;		
9	(D) A UTILITY BILL;		
10	(E) A PAY STUB; OR		
1	(F) A LETTER FROM A LOCAL, STATE, OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT		
12	AGENCY.		
13	(3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE WATER OR WASTEWATER BILL		
14	VIA ELECTRONIC MEANS, IF REQUESTED.		
15	(e) Tenant-water-utility customer requests.		
16	The property owner's or managing operator's refusal or failure to participate in a		
17	tenant-water-utility-customer's request to the Department for a discount, bill adjustment,		
18	payment plan, or other agency action may not be grounds for the Department to deny the		
19	request.		
20	(F) RESIDENTIAL-WATER-UTILITY CUSTOMER REQUESTS.		
21	THE DEPARTMENT MUST TIMELY PROVIDE A COPY OF A WATER OR WASTEWATER BILL TO		
22	A RESIDENTIAL-WATER-UTILITY CUSTOMER WHO:		
23	(1) REQUESTS A COPY OF A WATER OR WASTEWATER BILL ISSUED DURING A TIME		
24	PERIOD THE CUSTOMER WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE BILL; AND		
25	(2) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION THAT THE CUSTOMER OWNS AND OCCUPIES THE		
26	PROPERTY AS THE CUSTOMER'S PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE.		
27	<b>SECTION 2.</b> AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day		
28	after the date it is enacted.
