1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$38,520,093 shall be made available to the Fire Department – Service 602 (Fire Suppression and
3	Emergency Rescue) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
4	2025, to provide funding to balance the Fire Department's Fiscal Year 2025 budget to cover a
5	deficit caused by overtime, staffing costs, and contractual EMS services. The source of revenue
5	for this appropriation is General Fund assigned Fund Balance in excess of the amount from this
7	source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
3	balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.
