I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0334.

Repeal of Franchise – Private Bridgeway Above and Across the Bed of Hunter Street

For the purpose of repealing Ordinance 05-31, approved May 16, 2005, which granted permission to Printers’ Square Apartments Limited Partnership, to use and maintain a private enclosed bridgeway above and across the Hunter Street right-of-way; and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Transportation has approved the opening, closing and sale of the bed of Hunter Street in previous legislation. The franchise allowing use of the bridgeway is no longer relevant as the City has no interest in the property.

The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
