Major Issues Discussed

- Chairwoman McCray welcomed colleagues, members of the Administration, and attendees. Chairwoman introduced LO25-0002 for the purpose of calling for quarterly financial oversight hearings regarding the management, disbursement and status of \$641 million in federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Fiscal Relief Funds to the City of Baltimore.
- 2. The floor was open to a presentation from MORP by the Acting Chief Recovery Officer Elizabeth Tatum [See PowerPoint].
 - The presentation provided an overall update on the progress of expenditure and the current budget, with a focus on projects/agencies that are spending less than 50% of funds. In addition, the presentation included a brief update on the Opioid Restitution funds (included anticipated expenses and the initial disbursed payment).
- 3. At the end of the presentation, Chairwoman McCray opened the floor to questions from the committee members. Topics discussed in the hearing are as follows:
 - Determining equity in ARPA programs and how equity was prioritized [See further study request].
 - University of Baltimore is working on developing a Spend Analysis on Equity (in progress)
 - Addressing problems such as sidewalk repairs and traffic light structures –
 determined that the opportunity to use ARPA as a source of funding is limited since
 the city is passed the obligation deadline with Treasury and therefore cannot
 change the scope of work.
 - Determining the type of technical support MORP is providing as it relates to the Opioid Restitution Fund.
 - Collaboration with the Office of Overdose Response to include conversations with partners, site visits, budget review, qualitative feedback on grant applications.
 - Determining performance measures for Opioid Restitution funds that have been disbursed.
 - A combination of standard and unique measures has been established based on project design and collective impact
 - Concerns shared about the limited amount of funds available within the first year based on the settlement [See further study request].
 - A very small percentage going out to agencies (MORP's comments about a conservative approach based on lessons learned).
 - Multi-year grants
 - Determining the number of staff funded by ARPA that have/will transition to the general fund or another grant source [See further study request].
