3	For the purpose of expressing approval for the City of Baltimore to join ICLEI as a full member			
4	to participate in the Cities for Climate Protection Campaign, and, as a participant, to pledge			
5	to take a leadership role in promoting public awareness about the causes and impacts of			
6	climate change; and providing for a special effective date.			
7	WHEREAS, Scientific consensus has developed that carbon dioxide (CO <sup>2</sup> ) and other			
8	greenhouse gases released into the atmosphere have a profound effect on the Earth's climate; and			
9	WHEREAS, In 2006, the U.S. National Climatic Data Center confirmed clear evidence of			
10	human influences on climate, due to changes in greenhouse gases; and			
11	WHEREAS, The U.S. Conference of Mayors endorsed the 2005 U.S. Mayors' Climate			
12	Protection Agreement signed by more than 700 mayors in the United States, including the City			
13	of Baltimore; and			
14	WHEREAS, The Urban Environmental Accords adopted by local government delegates			
15	during UN World Environment Day 2005 call for reduced emissions through energy efficiency,			
16	land use and transportation planning, waste reduction, and wiser energy management; and			
17	WHEREAS, The 2000 U.S. Global Change Research Program's (USGCRP) First National			
18	Assessment indicated that global warming has begun; and			
19	WHEREAS, 162 countries, including the United States, pledged under the United Nations			
20	Framework Convention on Climate Change to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions; and			
21	WHEREAS, Local government actions taken to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and increase			
22	energy efficiency provide multiple local benefits by decreasing air pollution, creating jobs,			
23	reducing energy expenditures, and saving money for the local government, its businesses, and its			
24	residents; and			
25	WHEREAS, The City of Baltimore has initiated a process to complete a Sustainability Plan			
26	and implementation program, established an Office of Sustainability, Environmental Sub-			
27	Cabinet and Sustainability Advisory Commission; and

16 17	<ul> <li>Develop an action plan with both existing and future actions that when implemented will meet the local greenhouse gas reduction target;</li> </ul>				
18	• Implement the action plan; and
