Re: **City Council Bill 17-0124 - City Streets - Opening - Portion of a 4-Foot Alley Extending from West Eager Street**

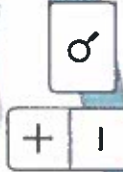
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0124, for the purpose of condemning and opening a portion of a 4-foot alley, extending from West Eager Street southerly 75 feet, more or less, to the outline of the property known as 917 Cathedral Street, as shown on Plat 158-A-78 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, a companion bill to CC 17-0125 (City Streets – Closing 4-foot Alley Extending from West Eager Street), would open a portion of a 4-foot alley as part of the process necessary for moving forward with the closure of the 4-foot alley that is no longer needed.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 17-0124.

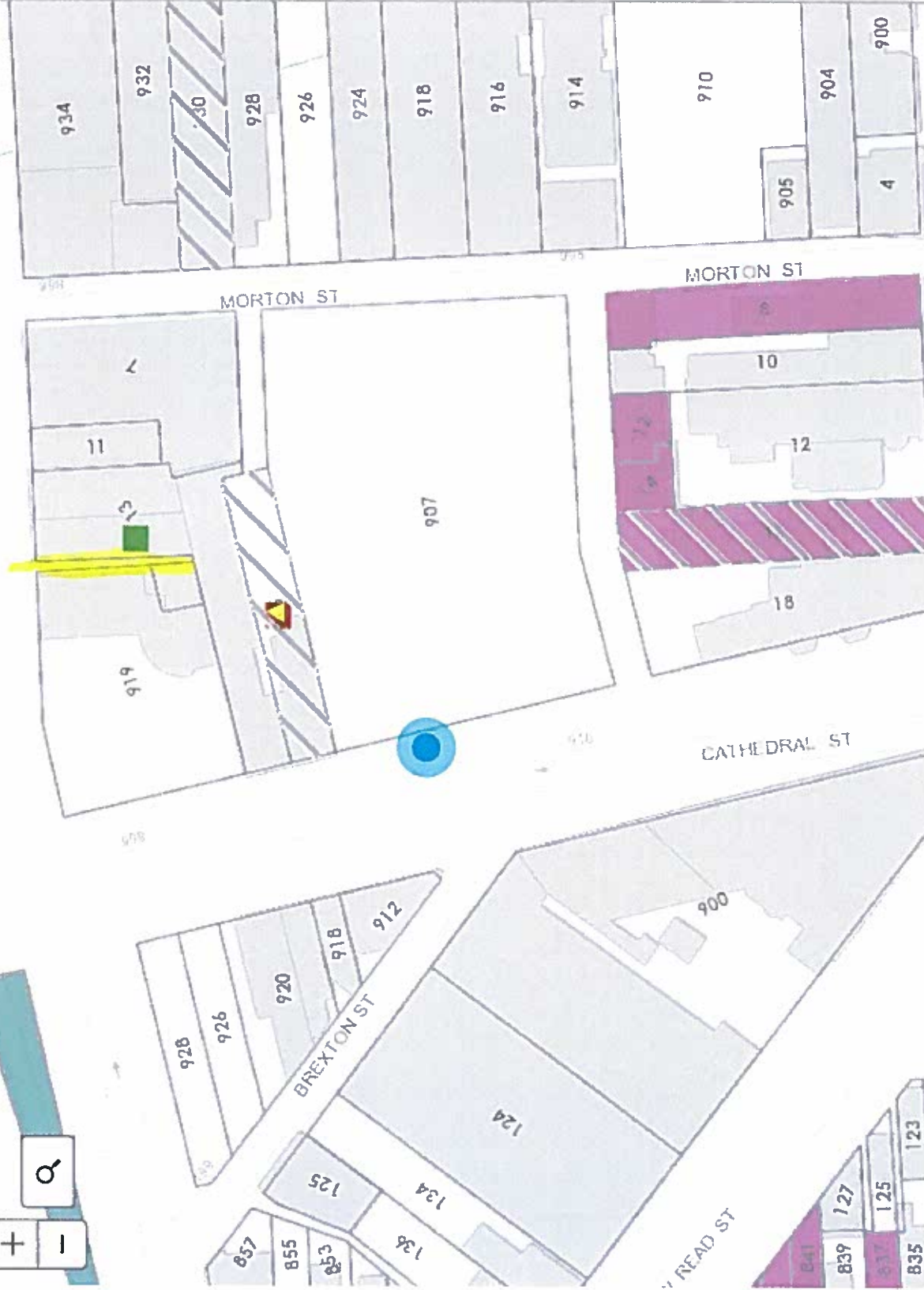
