FOR the purpose of designating the Home of the Friendless, 1313 Druid Hill Avenue, as an historical landmark: exterior; and providing for a special effective date.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation
Section 18A-3
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2020s

§ 18A-3. HOME OF THE FRIENDLESS.


HOME OF THE FRIENDLESS, 1313 DRUID HILL AVENUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.




