INLAND FLOODING & DOT



Mitigation

- DOT actively works with sister city agencies in mitigating the impact if potential inland flooding events.
- This includes active communication & planning with MOEM, DPW, and Planning, among other stakeholders.
- DOT engineers investigate DOT infrastructure at risk of being impacted by inland flooding.
- In cases where DOT infrastructure risks be undermined as a result of flooding, the agency implements preventative measures.


INLAND FLOODING & DOT



Response

- In anticipation of both coastal and inland flooding events, DOT's Maintenance Division coordinates public sandbag filling and pickup, often in multiple City neighborhoods prone to flooding.
- DOT Traffic Division implements roadway closures on corridors at risk of being flooded, or that have flooded, and coordinates detours.
- DOT works to repair and restore damaged infrastructure resulting from flooding.
- When eligible, DOT seeks reimbursement for incurred expenses from the Federal Highway Administration and State Highway Administration.
