4	amount of \$1,600,500 to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201 (Field		
5	Operations), to provide funding for planning, equipment, training, exercises, management		
6	and administration of protective actions aimed to enhance the ability of State and local		
7	agencies to prevent, respond to, recover from incidents of terrorism, and reduce the		
8 9	vulnerabilities around identified critical infrastructure and key resource locations/sites; and providing for a special effective date.

16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland		
17	Emergency Management Agency (MEMA), U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of		
18	Domestic Preparedness in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in		
19	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.		
20	That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of		
21	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.		
22	On November 2, 2005, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City		
23	Council.		
24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That		
25	\$1,600,500 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201		
26	(Field Operations) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
