SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 10. Credits

§ 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.

(m) *Termination of program.*

Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after ~~February 28, [2023]~~
2028 [February 28, 2023] AUGUST 28, 2024.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
enacted.
