Re: City Council Bill 24-0568 Community Relations Commission – Powers and  
Duties – Complaint Period

The Law Department has reviewed Mayor and City Council Bill 24-568 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would increase the time within which complaints of unlawful practices must be filed with the Community Relations Commission; make certain related amendments; and provide for a special effective date. The bill extends the time period for filing a complaint from 180 days to 300 days.

As there are no legal impediments to this bill, the Law Department can approve it for form and legal sufficiency
