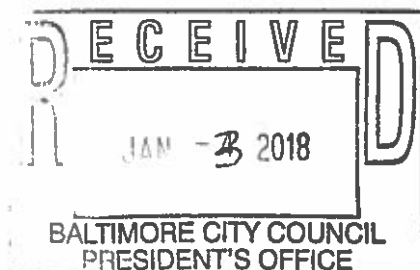
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and has no objection to the passage of Bill No. 17-0169.

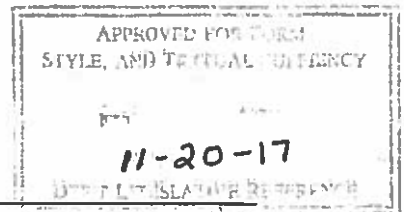

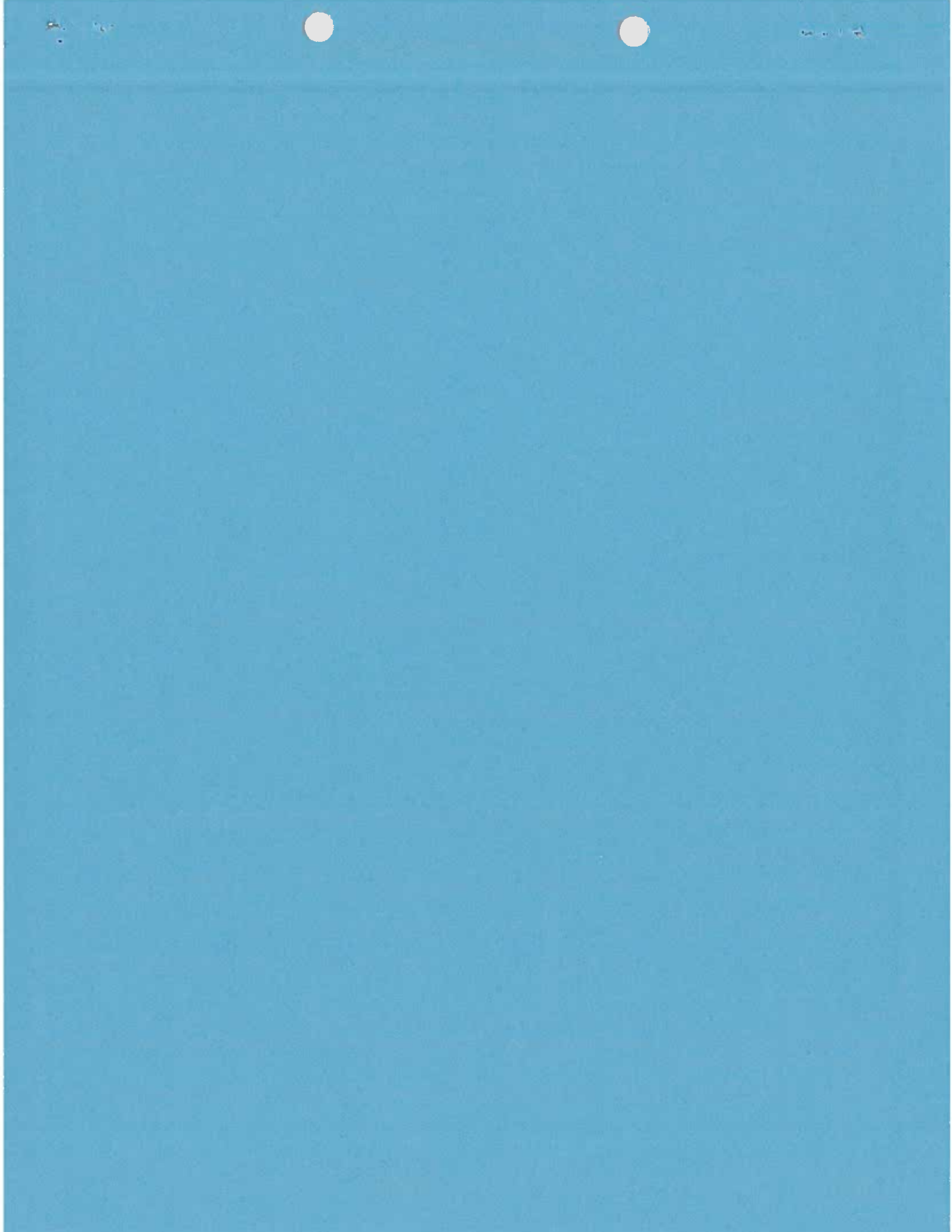
