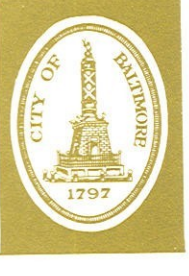

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0332.

Conditional Use Housing for the Elderly – 3020-3026 Garrison Boulevard and 3801 and 3803 Bonner Road

For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of housing for the elderly as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

The Department of Transportation has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0332 - Conditional Use Housing for the Elderly. The bill proposes to allow for the construction of housing for the elderly on certain assembled lots. The project is sponsored by Wayland Baptist Church. It would house 90 adults and would include 60 off-street parking spaces. The Department of Transportation has no objections to this bill and defers to the Department of Planning.
