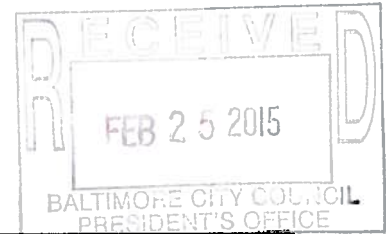
This CCB 15-0200R Investigative Hearing – Valet Parking Program is for the purpose of calling on representatives of the Departments of Finance and Transportation, the Parking Authority of Baltimore City, the BMZA, and the Baltimore City Police Department to appear before the City Council and report on the implementation of the valet parking program created by ordinance in 2013.

Analysis

This resolution requires the above mentioned entities to appear before the Council and report on the implementation of the valet parking program as well as revenue generated as a result of the law.
