City Council Bill 11-0719 - Rezoning - 403-435 North Washington Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0719, which was introduced for the purpose of changing the zoning for the properties known as 403-435 North Washington Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-8 Zoning District to the

This bill, along with companion legislation, City Council Bill 11-0718 (which permits the designation of O-R use within the Middle East Urban Renewal Plan), would rezone certain properties on the odd side of the 400 block of North Washington Street into the newly permitted O-R-2 designation. The subject properties are located one block to the east of the Johns Hopkins Medical Campus' new Adult and Children's Urgent Care Hospital twelve-story tower. It is the understanding of the Department of Housing and Community Development developer intends to (and has submitted plans for) build four-story office building with ground level parking and lease space to target renters who need office space in support of
