INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill No. 21-0068R introduced by Councilmembers Middleton, McCray, Bullock, Ramos, Porter, Torrence, Cohen, Burnett, and Conway.

PURPOSE

For the purpose of inviting representatives of city agencies, including the Baltimore Development Corporation, to testify to the City Council regarding the standards, procedures, practices, and policies for naming and renaming City property and the ceremonial naming of City streets, and to discuss possible revisions of current standards, in light of national trends, so that our standards better foster equity and unity.

BRIEF HISTORY

The City regularly names and renames properties to commemorate historic figures and events of significance to Baltimore City. This Bill invites representatives from agencies, including BDC, to discuss the current practices around this process.
