## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 2	Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation – Fire Department – \$114,009
3	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
4	amount of \$114,009 to the Fire Department – Service 608 (Emergency Management), to
5	provide funding for first responder quarantine costs resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic
6	and providing for a special effective date.

12	Recitals
13 14 15	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.
16 17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated.
18	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
19	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated or is for a new program that could
20	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
21	On September 15, 2021, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
22	Council.

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$114,009 shall be made available to the Fire Department – Service 608 (Emergency
3	Management) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021,
4	to provide funding for first responder quarantine costs resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.
5	The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from FEMA in excess of the amount from
6	this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
7	balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
