- illegal dumping

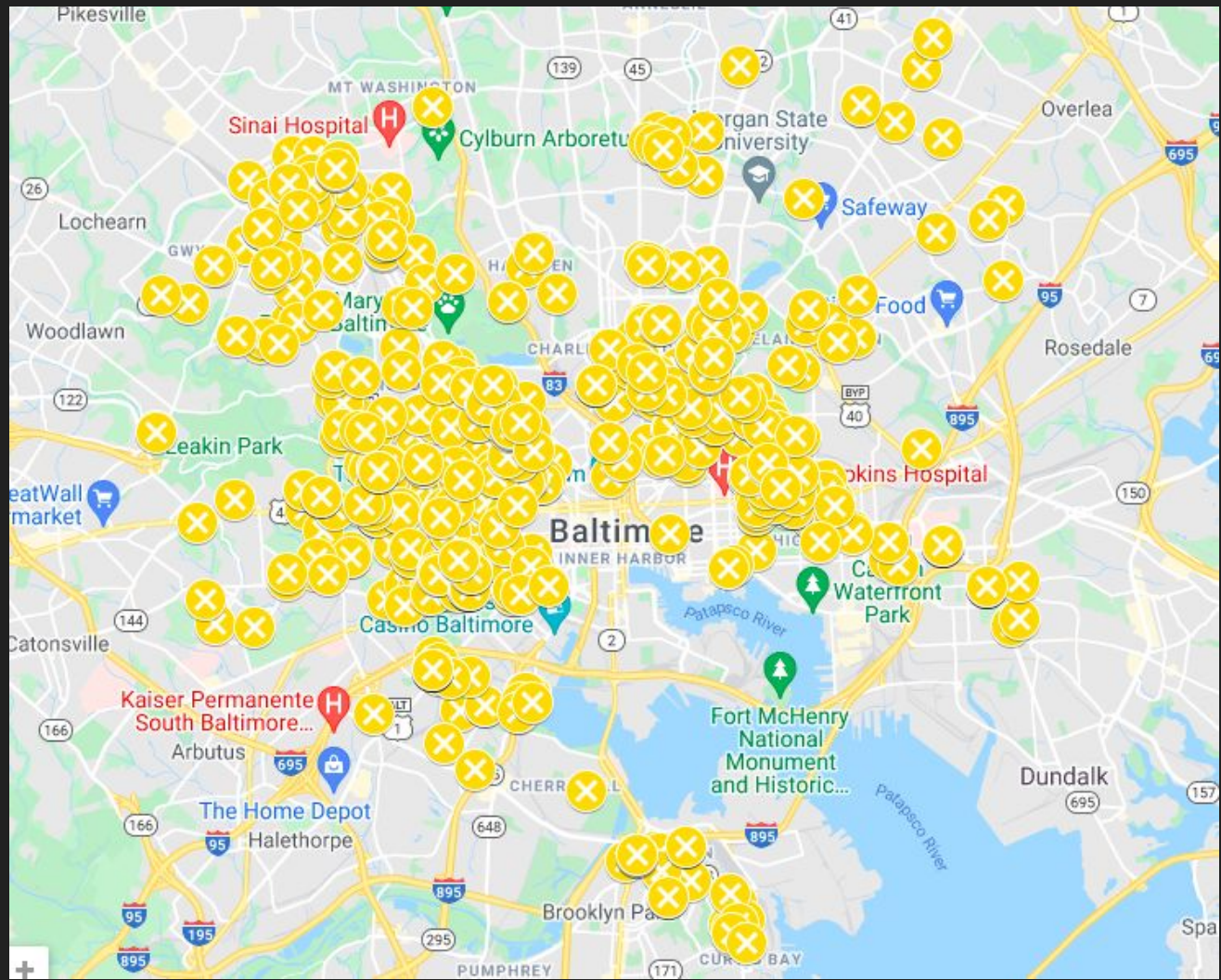
BPD's Top 10 posts

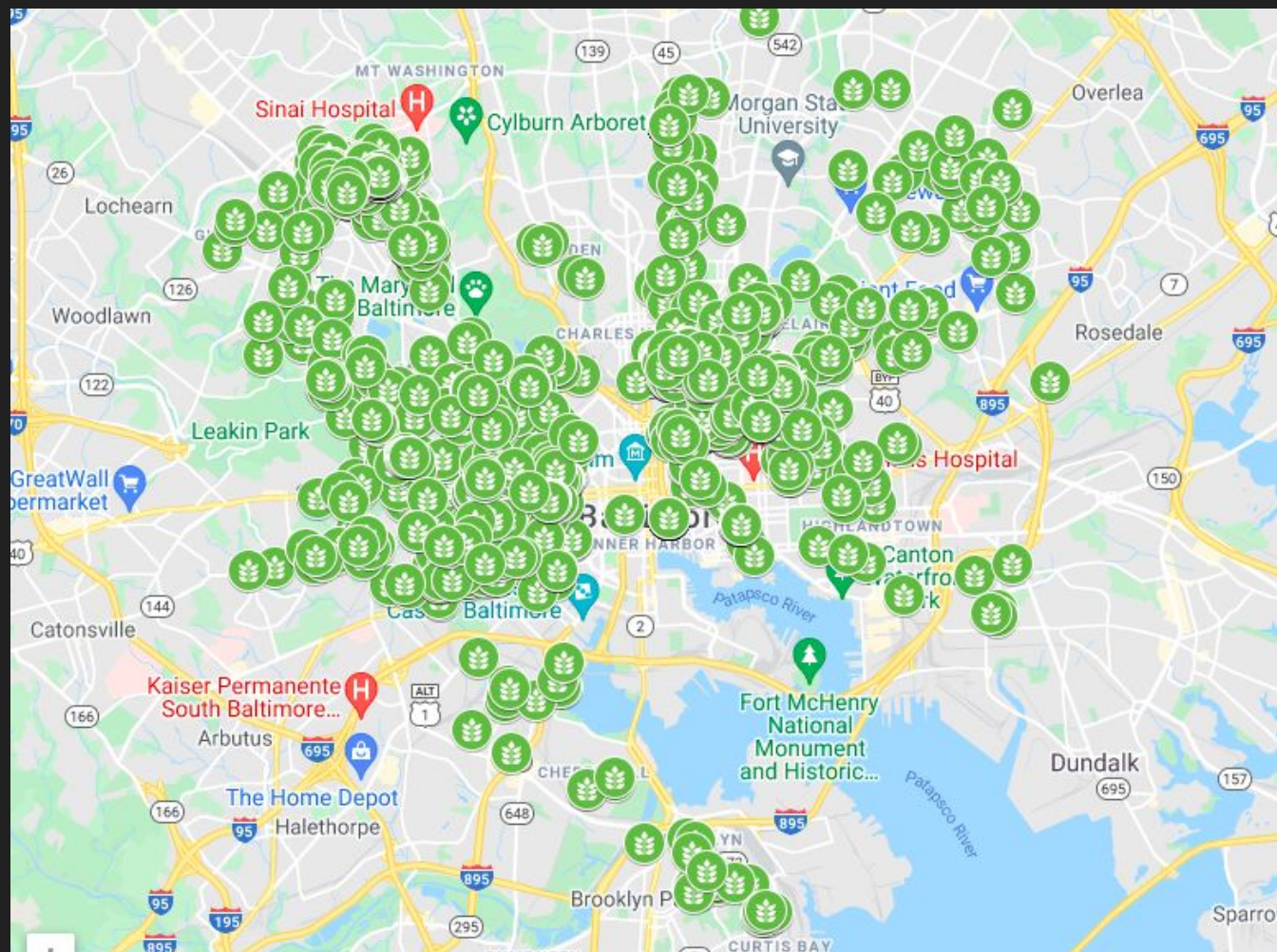

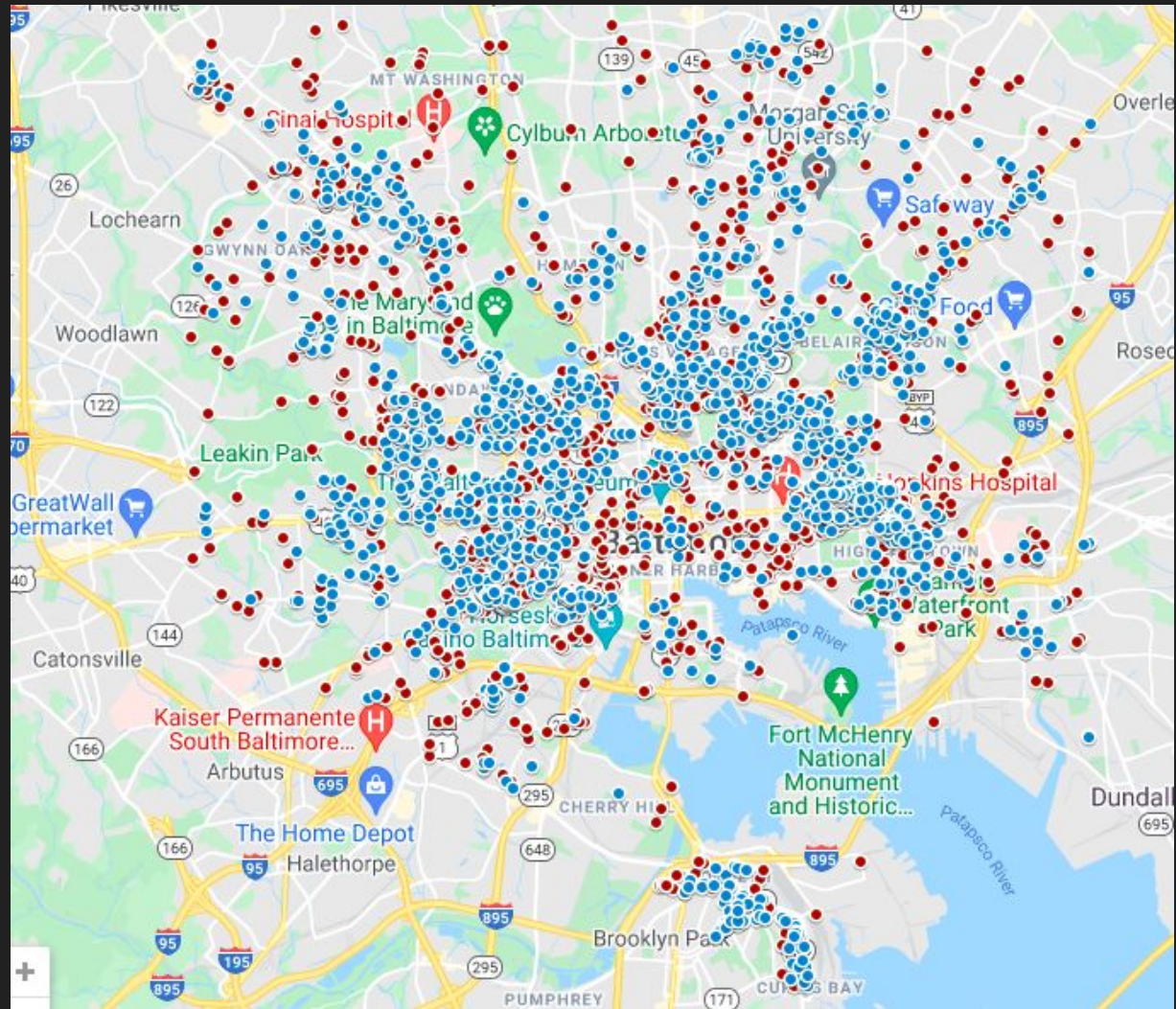

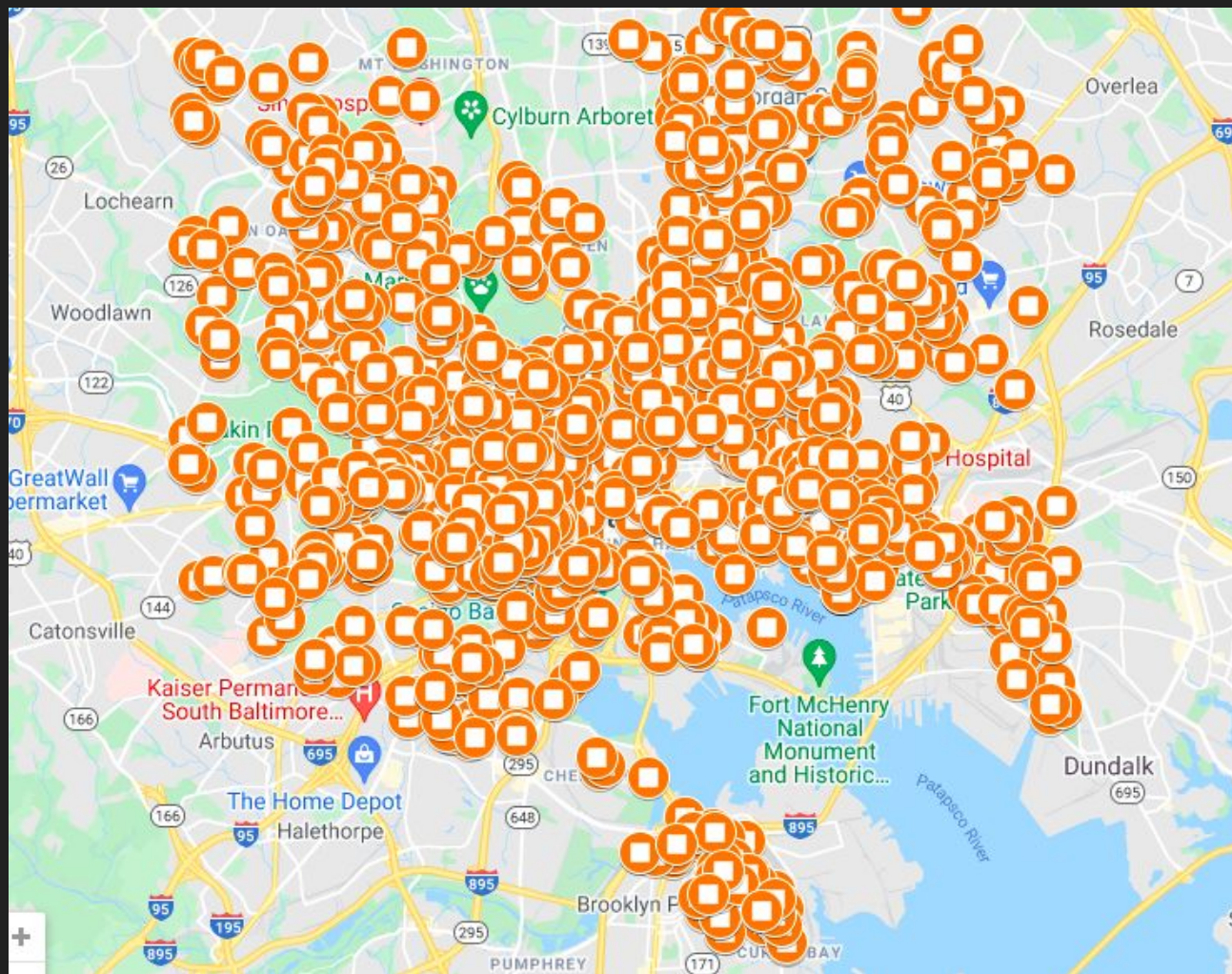


Dirty streets

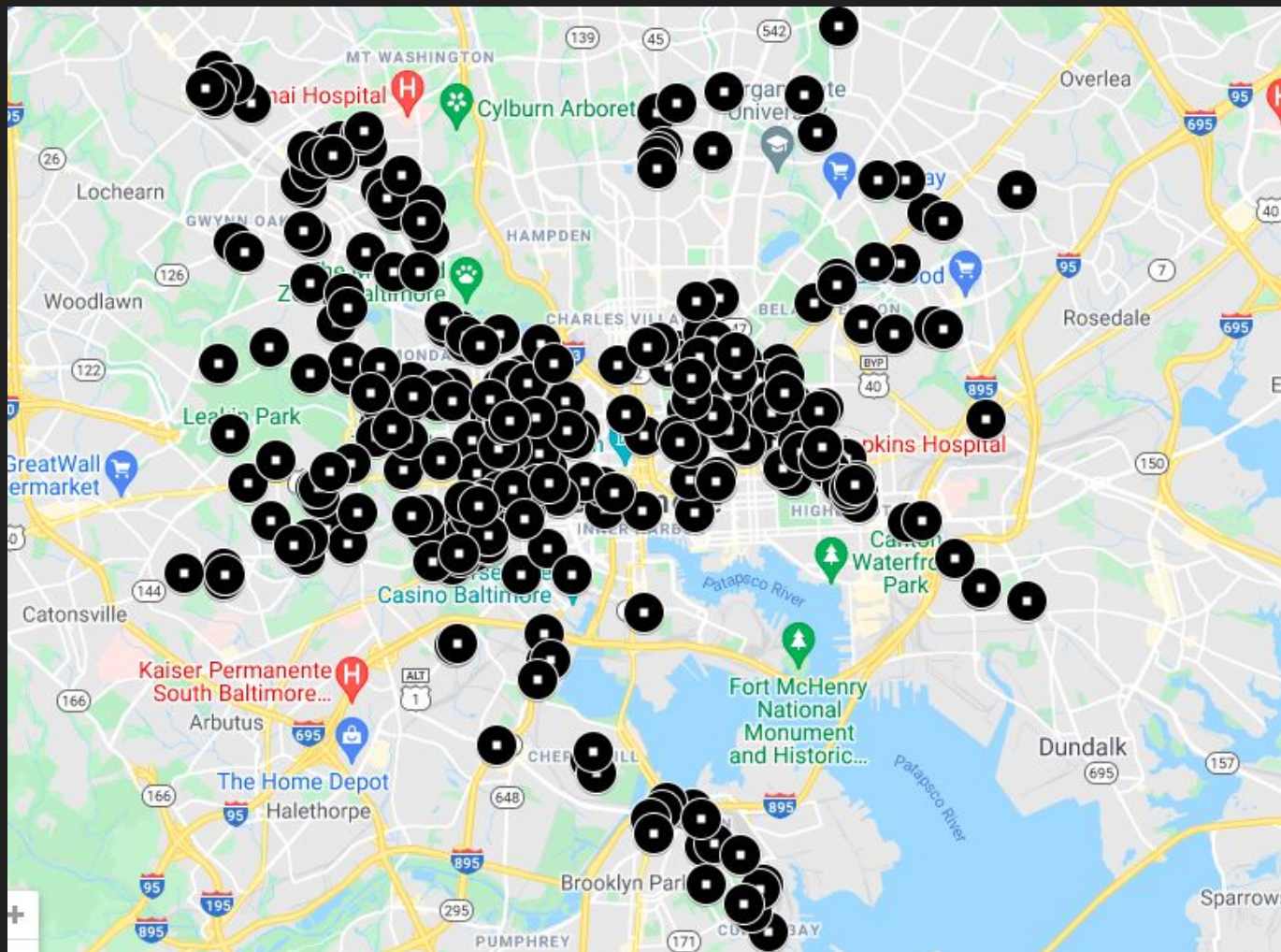


Illegal Dumping

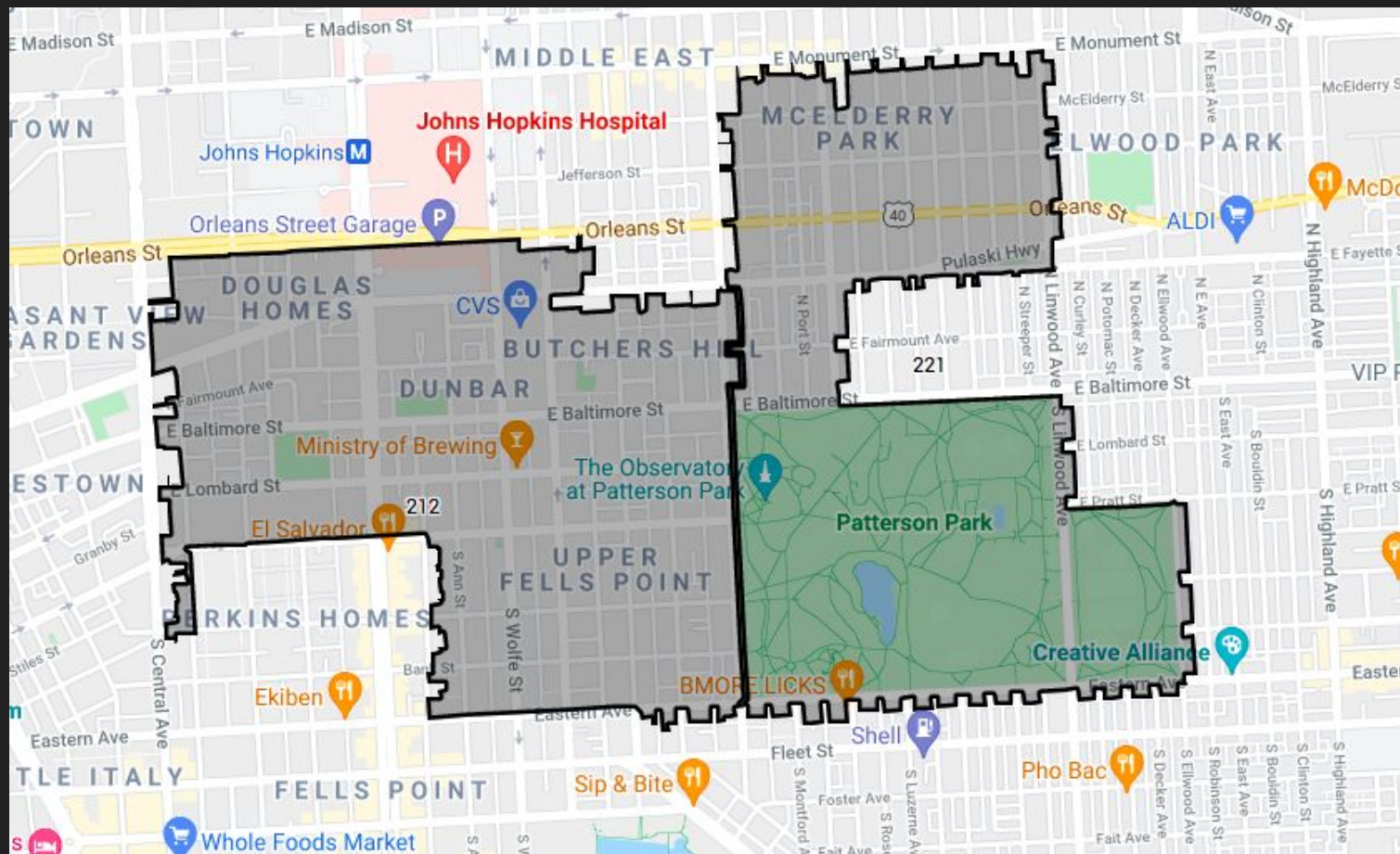

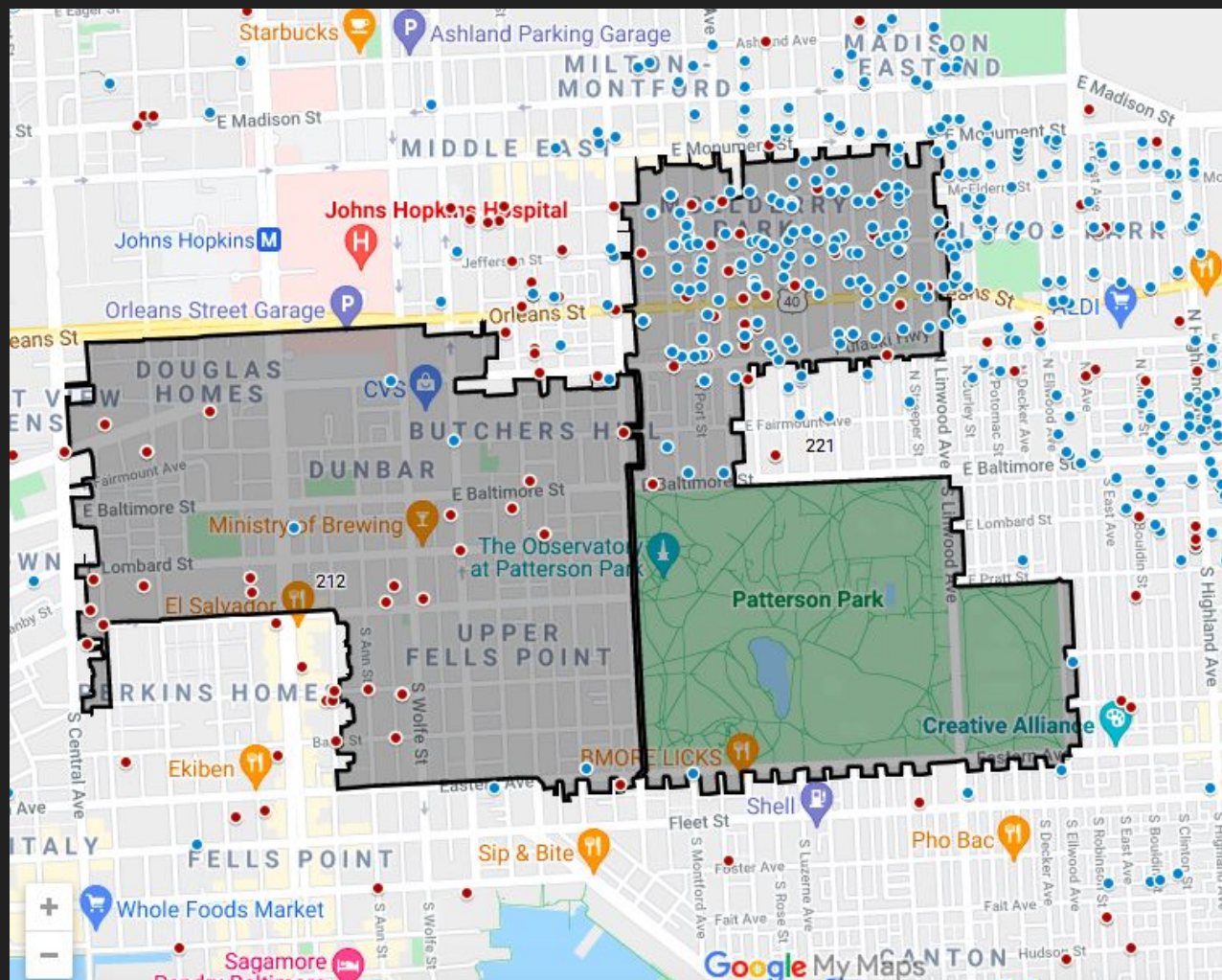

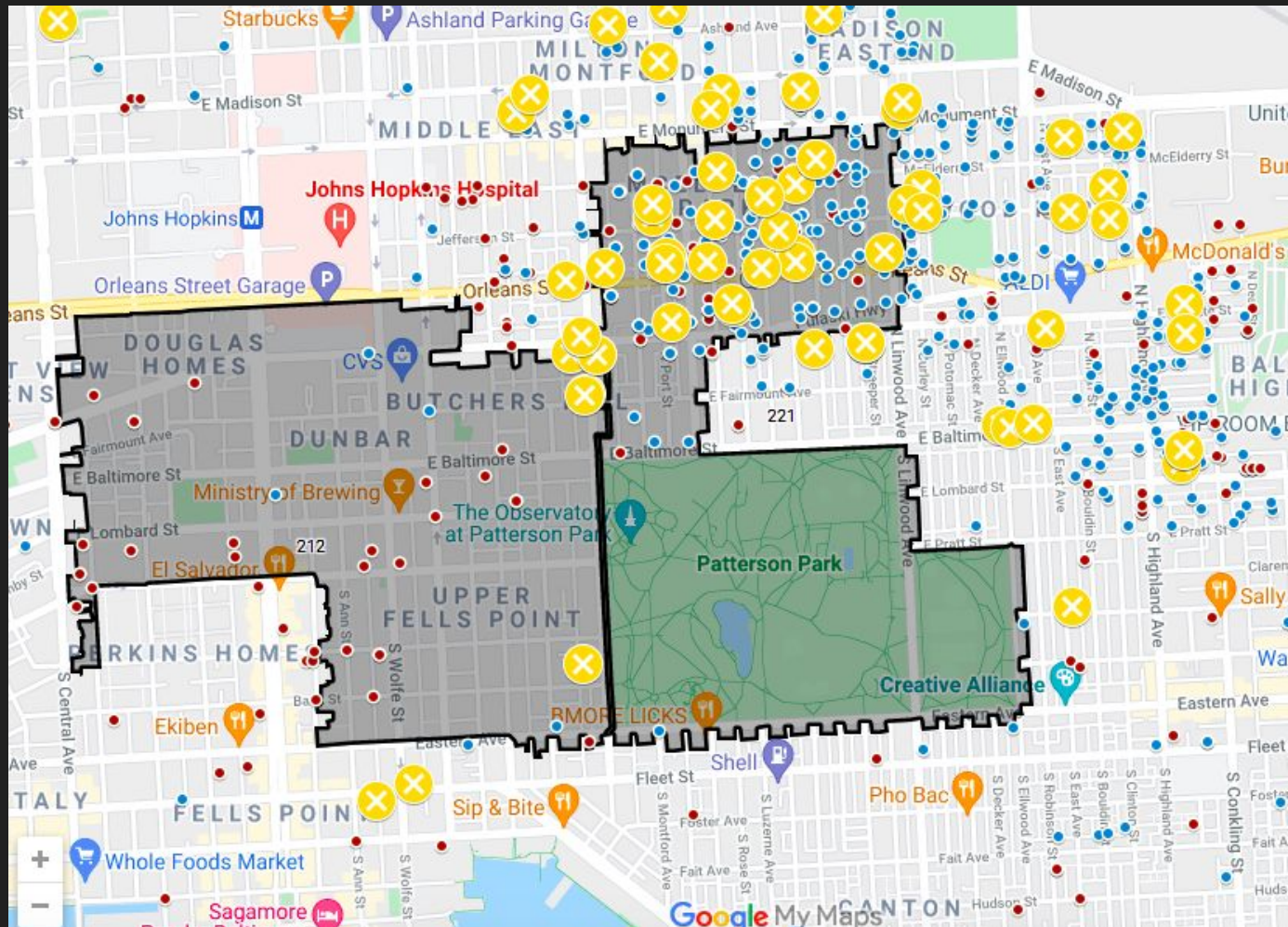

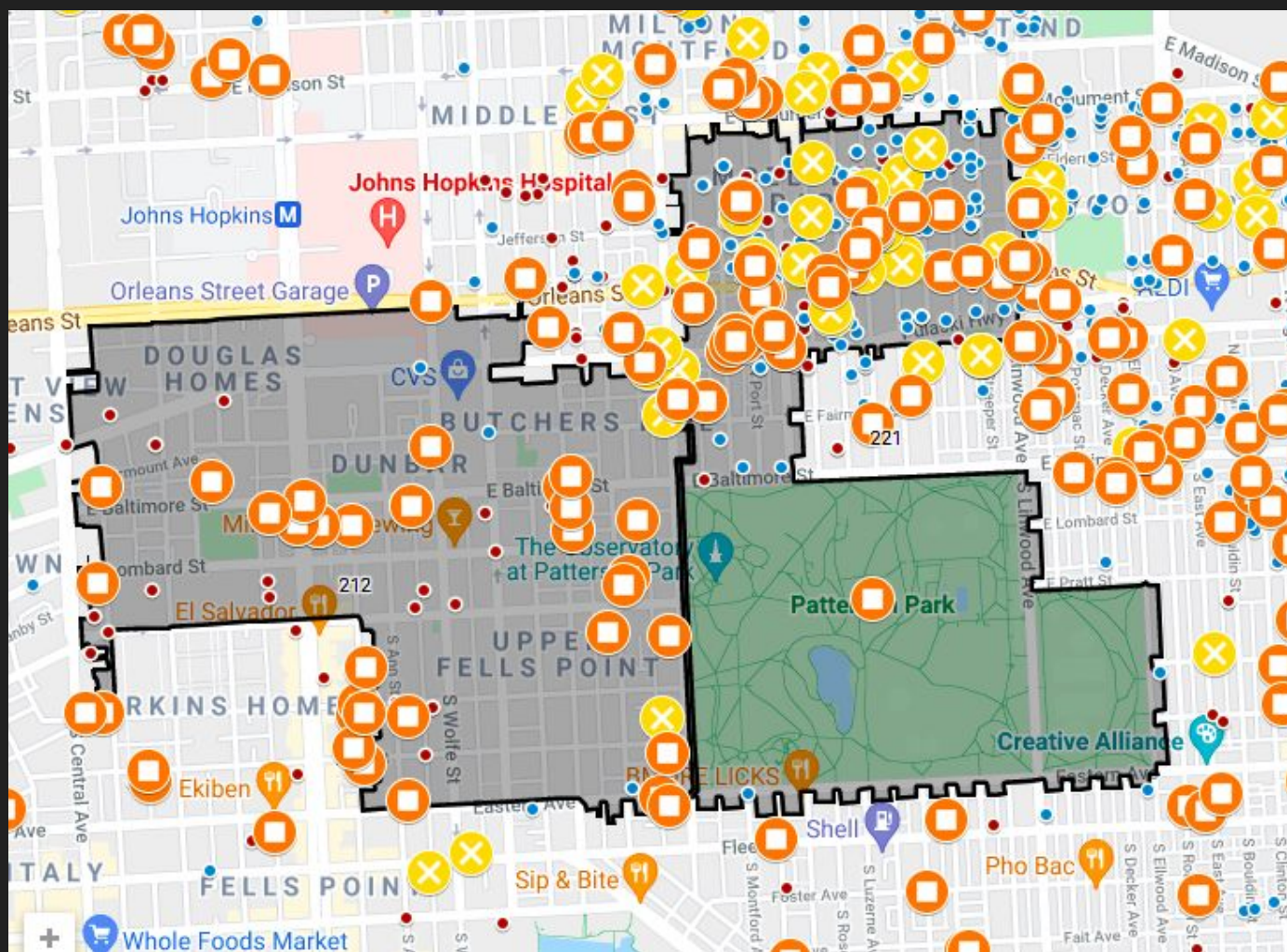


Housing inspection - Vacant residential building (last 3 months)

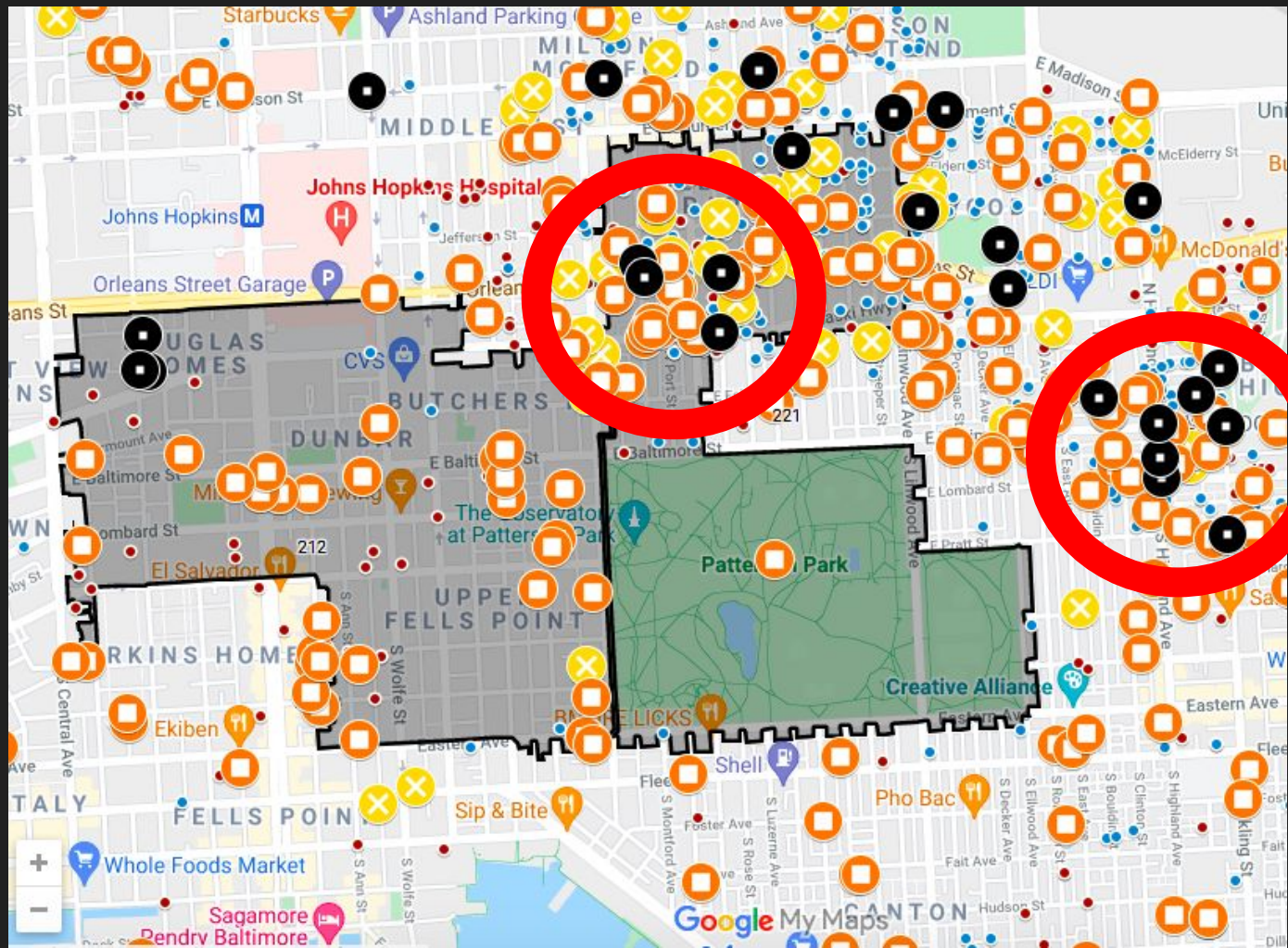

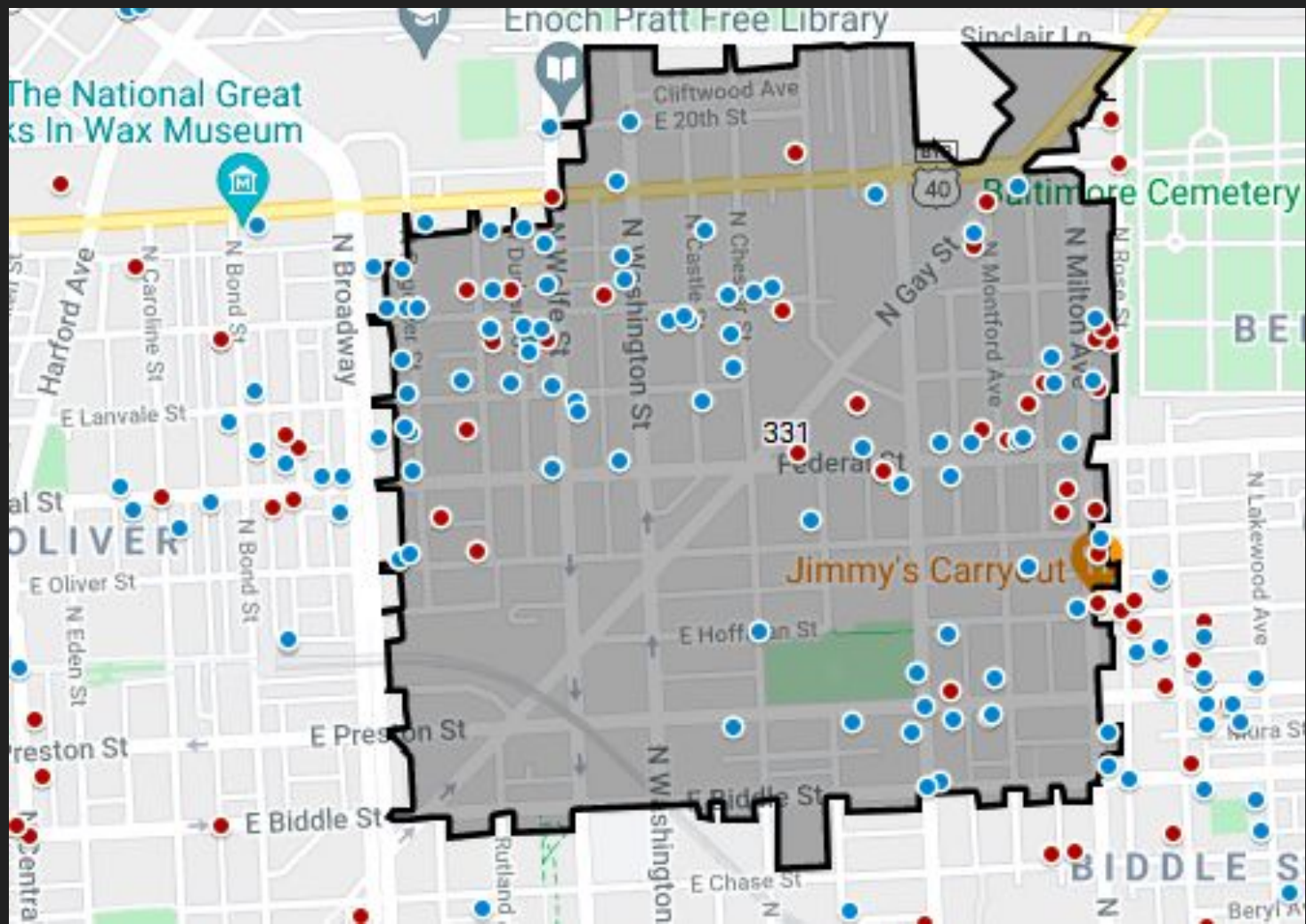

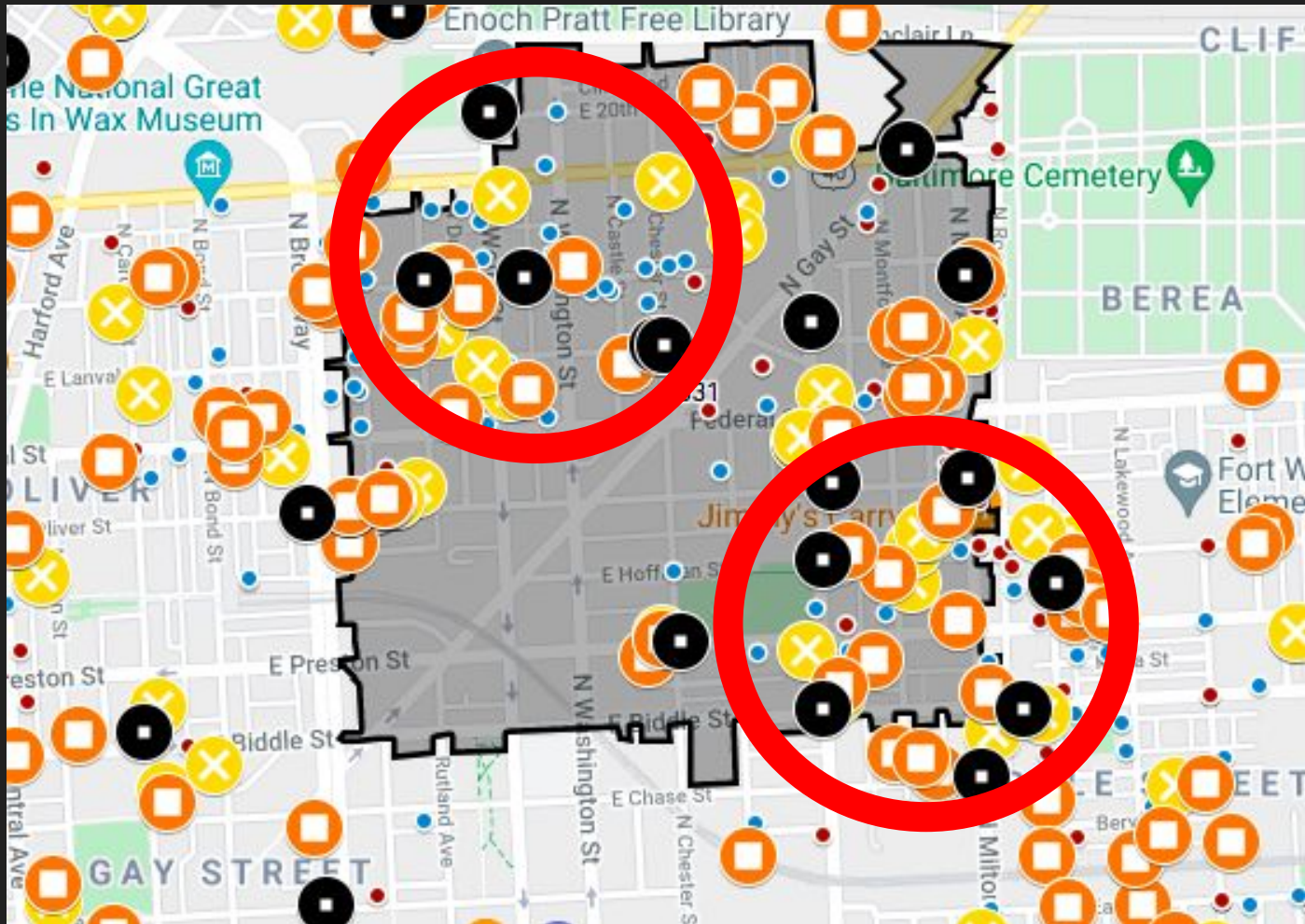

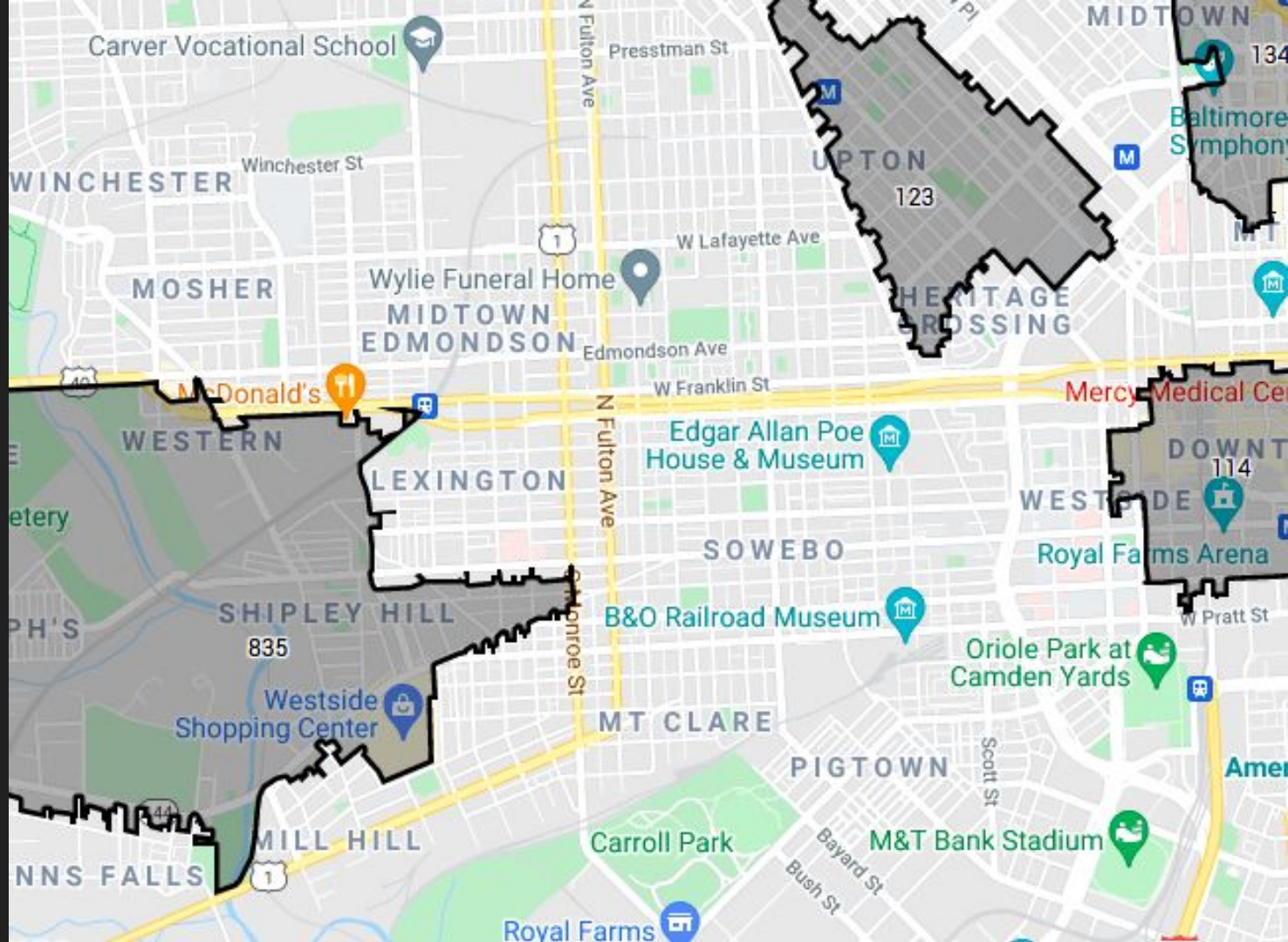

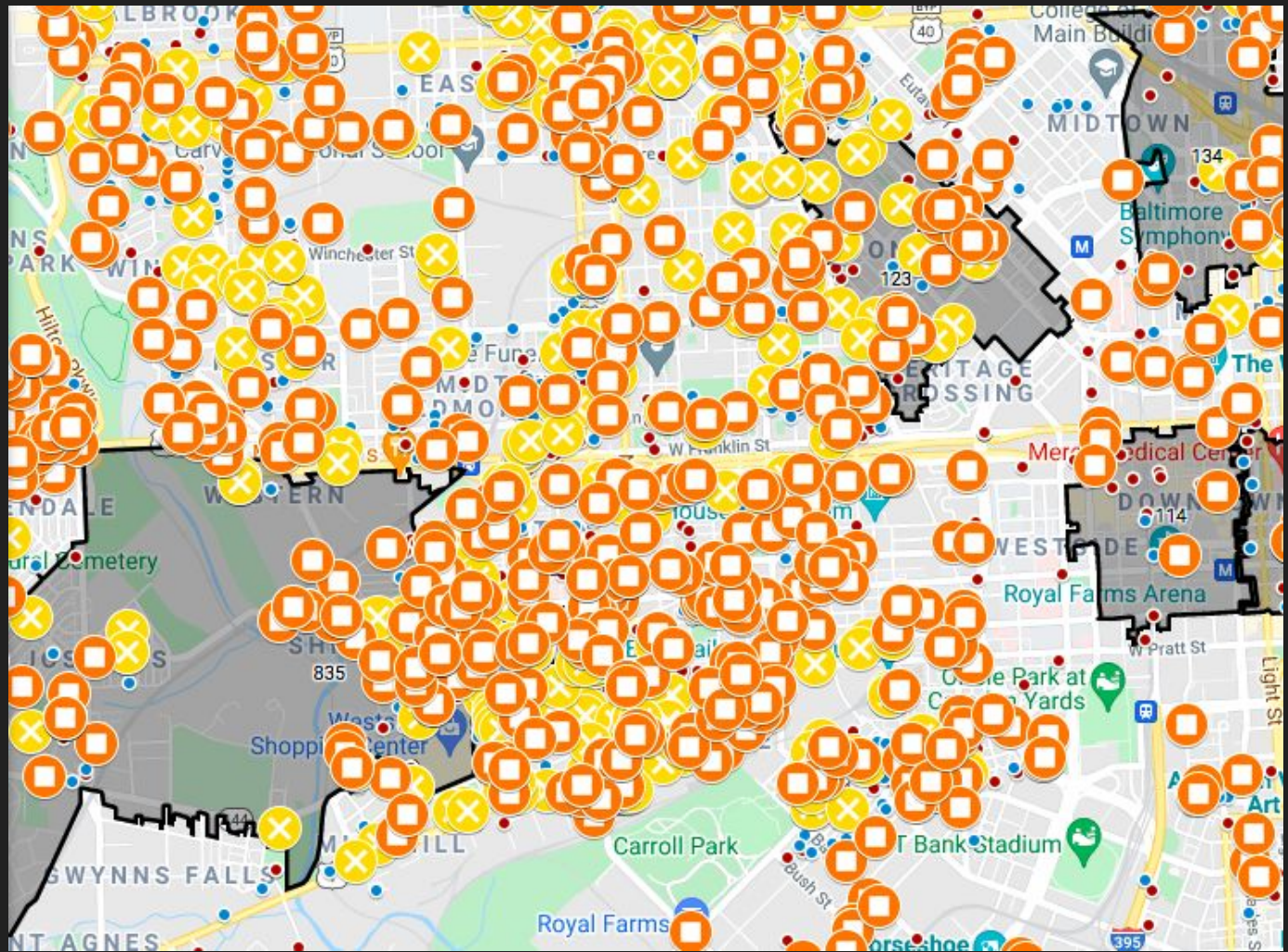


Housing inspection - Vacant residential building (last 3 months)

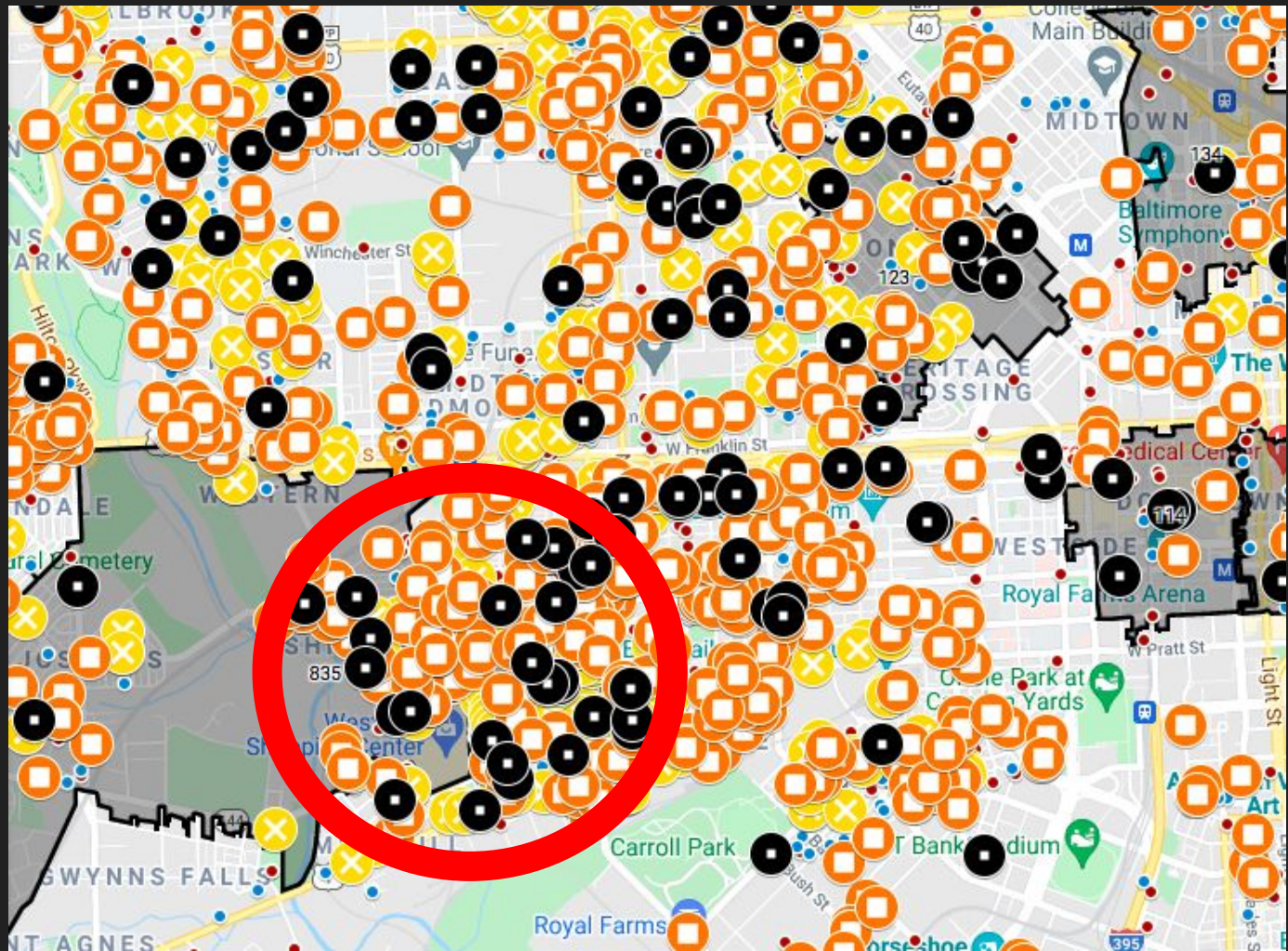


+Illegal Dumping
