FOR the purpose of extending the period within which applications may be accepted for the
historic improvement tax credit and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 10. Credits

§ 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.

(m) *Termination of program.*

Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after February 28, [2022]
2023.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
enacted.
