1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$2,350,000 shall be made available to the Fire Department – Service 602 (Fire Suppression and
3	Emergency Rescue) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
4	2021, to provide funding for the cost of operating 2 fire suppression companies. The source of
5	revenue for this appropriation is funds from Red Light Fines in excess of the amount from this
6	source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
7	balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
