17	An amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Canton Industrial Area is necessary to		
18	revise the boundary of the existing Urban Renewal Plan and revise the exhibits to reflect the		
19	changes in the Plan.		
20	Under Article 13, § 2-6 of the Baltimore City Code, no change may be made in any approved		
21	renewal plan unless the change is approved in the same manner as that required for the approval		
22	of a renewal plan.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That if any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, the invalidity does not affect any other provision or any other application of this Ordinance, and for this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That if a provision of this Ordinance concerns the same subject as a provision of any zoning, building, electrical, plumbing, health, fire, or safety law or regulation, the applicable provisions shall be construed to give effect to each. However, if the provisions are found to be in irreconcilable conflict, the one that establishes the higher standard for the protection of the public health and safety prevails. If a provision of this Ordinance is found to be in conflict with an existing provision of any other law or regulation that establishes a lower standard for the protection of the public health and safety, the provision of this Ordinance prevails and the other conflicting provision is repealed to the extent of the conflict.
