We now only live in one room in the house. We had to seal my daughter's room off and she went to live with family. I have persistent nose bleeds and difficulty breathing. The ceiling is still caving in. The home is rotting from the inside. I call the inspector but when they notify the landlord the landlord calls me and tells me that he does not want them in his home and tells me I better not let them in. I would let them in but the inspectors have not come after they would speak with the landlord. I asked him for a lead certificate, and he told me that he doesn't have to provide one. We need help. We need this to stop.
