INTRODUCTION – Rezoning - Block 3635, Lot 055

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as Block 3635, Lot 055, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the C-4 Zoning District to the C-1 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 21-0166 looks to rezone the property known as Block 3635, Lot 055, from the C-4 Zoning District to the C-1 Zoning District. The City's Zoning Code designates C-4 Zoning Districts as being areas reserved for heavy commercial use, often associated with automobiles or storage. C-1 Zoning Districts are classified as serving lighter commercial use, generally pedestrian oriented. The legislation's statement of intent articulates that the applicant intends to develop the property for residential purposes.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation does not foresee any direct fiscal or operational impact resulting from this legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 21-0166.
