

Aligned Grantmaking Fund



The Summer Funding Collaborative is a partnership between public, private and nonprofit organizations that supports high-quality summer programs serving children and youth from low-income backgrounds in Baltimore City.

The goal: To fund different types of summer programs to keep students engaged and reduce summer learning loss so that more youth can reach their full potential.

The BCYF Grassroots Fund addresses traditional gaps in Baltimore's funding landscape by providing unrestricted funding for grassroots, Baltimore-based, youth-serving organizations in support of an organization's overall mission.

In addition to financial support, organizations awarded a grant from the Grassroots Fund will also receive rigorous capacity-building support to help them sustain and

grow.

Eligibility

Grassroots organizations are defined as community accountable organizations with an annual operating budget of under \$250,000.

The Fund will prioritize organizations led by Black, Brown, Indigenous, and Asian people.

BC BALTIMORE CHILDREN & Y F YOUTH FUND

Eligibility for the Grassroots Fund

You should apply if your organization:

1) is Baltimore City-based and serves children and youth ages 24 years and under.

2) is a Maryland 501(c)(3) organization or has a confirmed Fiscal Sponsorship.


3) has an organizational budget that totals \$250,000 or less.

The Application

On March 15, 2022, BCYF will publish a new expanded Request for Proposals with a grant application workbook, applicant checklist, and policies and procedures for managing a BCYF grant award.



Grant Awards

The Spring grant cycle will accept and review all applications from eligible organizations.

BCYF will award approximately 35 grants.

The Fund will award \$150,000 three-year grants to eligible community accountable organizations. The grants are payable in equal installments over three years.

Grassroots Fund

The Spring grant cycle will accept and review all applications from eligible organizations. BCYF will also provide robust technical assistance for applicants. The Fund will award a grant totaling \$150,000 over three years to eligible community accountable organizations.
