**Subject:** City Council Bill 22-0197

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 22-0197, introduced by Councilmember Costello.

The purpose of this bill is to modify the hours of applicable parking restrictions for Residential Parking Plan Area 31 (Townes at the Terraces); reduce the non-permit parking time threshold; establish an exception to the applicable permit limit; and correct and conform related provisions.

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City (PABC) has reviewed the proposed legislation and discussed the intent of the bill with both the Councilmember and the RPP Advisory Board Member for RPP Area 31. Prior to this legislation's introduction, the Councilmember's Office and the RPP Advisory Board Member have engaged with and received support on this initiative from the local residents and Mother Mary Lange Catholic School.

As this is a community-based program and this legislation has community support, the PABC does not oppose the passage of City Council Bill 22-0197.
