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**AN RESOLUTION CONCERNING**

1                   A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL concerning

2                   **South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact District and Management Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of reviewing the South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact District and  
4 Management Authority and renewing the South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact  
5 District and Management Authority if the Council finds that District and the Management  
6 Authority are effective and should continue; and providing for a special effective date.

7                   **Recitals**

8                   In 2016, Ordinance 16-509 was enacted, creating the South Baltimore Gateway Community  
9 Impact District and Management Authority (“the District and the Authority”). City Charter  
10 Article II, § 69(g) provides that the Mayor and City Council shall “review the effectiveness and  
11 determine the desirability of continuing the existence” of the South Baltimore Gateway  
12 Community Impact District every 4 years from the enactment of Ordinance 16-509. The City  
13 Council must now review the South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact District and  
14 Management Authority to determine the effectiveness and the desirability of continuing the  
15 District and Management Authority.

16                   **SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That,  
17 beginning at its second meeting in October 2021, the Mayor and City Council shall review and  
18 determine the desirability of continuing the District and the Authority.

19                   **SECTION 2. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That, if  
20 the Mayor and City Council find that it is desirable for the District and Authority to continue, the  
21 District and Authority shall continue for the next 4 years.
