Dear Mr. President and City Council Members:

City Council Bill 22-0211 was referred to the Employees' and Elected Officials' Retirement Systems ("ERS") for comment. The bill's stated purpose is for establishing the Employee and Retiree Health Benefits Program for Baltimore City employees; defining certain terms; providing for the administration of the Program; establishing membership, procedures, and duties for the City Health Insurance Committee; requiring certain reports and the provision of certain data; and generally relating to healthcare for City employees, retirees, their spouses, and their dependents.

Since there are no proposed changes to Article 22 within the bill, the ERS anticipates no impact to the Plan and therefore, takes no position regarding Bill 22-0211.
