BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows: 10 11 **Baltimore City Code** 12 Article 31. Transit and Traffic Subtitle 1. Definitions; General Provisions 13 § Definitions – A to L. 14 (f) Commercial Vehicle. 15 "Commercial vehicle" means: 16 17 (1) every vehicle designed, maintained, and used primarily for the transportation or hauling of property, including but not limited to equipment, merchandise, parcels, 18 earth, trash, refuse, scrap, or motor vehicles; 19 (2) every vehicle, except a passenger car (as defined in Maryland Vehicle Law 20 21 § 11-144.1), that has commercial advertising on the exterior of the vehicle or on equipment attached to the vehicle; 22

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1 2	(3) every vehicle that has a maximum gross vehicle weight of 7,000 pounds or more or a manufacturer's rated capacity of ³ / ₄ -ton or more; [and]
3 4	(4) every vehicle that is designed to carry more than 15 passengers and is used to carry people[.]; AND
5	(5) EVERY VEHICLE THAT HAS ANY TRAILER ATTACHED.

6 **SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
