SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the Comptroller of Baltimore City may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property located at 2001 Park Avenue (Block 3448; Lot 030), also known as the Brickhead Estate, the Bond House, Mount Royal, Norse Hill Home, and the Norwegian Seaman's Merchants Home, containing 1.835 acres, more or less, and improved by a 3 story building containing 15,194 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.

 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
