### **INTRODUCTION**

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill No. 21-0156 introduced by Council President Mosby.

## **PURPOSE**

This Bill would permit the establishment, maintenance, and operation of an open off-street parking area on the properties known as 1207 and 1209 E. 43rd Street and 1204 Springfield Avenue.

#### **BRIEF HISTORY**

The collective parcels addressed by this legislation are proposed to be connected and expand parking capacity for the nearby League of People with Disabilities headquarters, which owns these parcels. If conditional use is granted, the subsequent Site Plan Review Committee (SPRC) process should ensure that parking/loading demands are adequately addressed, and that any negative effects of the proposed use on the surrounding residential neighborhood are mitigated.
