







Gun Arrests by District










DISTRICT HOMICIDE COMPARISON

UPDATES ON 5-YEAR PLAN

BPD continues to make progress on achieving goals set forth in the Five Year Transformation Plan:

 MANAGEMENT TRAINING: Completed week long training for more than 20 management level members (lieutenants, captains, and majors) with 9 additional members registered to complete Senior Management Institute for Police

IT PROJECTS:

- Data Warehouse procurement completed. Configuration in progress.
- EIS Draft RFP SOW section (including Requirements and Use Cases) completed.

CONSENT DECREE:

- Ongoing 2-day in-service training on Youth Interactions and Behavioral Health
- Use of Force policies under review; will be available for public feedback later this summer
- SMART POLICING: Beginning July 3rd, BPD will be automatically sending telephone eligible calls for service to the Telephone Reporting Unit
- CIVILIANIZATION: BPD has received 775+ applications for the 35 civilian investigator positions that were authorized in FY23 budget
