The Department of Finance is herein reporting on City Council Bill 22-0216, City Property-Grant of Easement, the purpose of which is to grant a perpetual easement to the Maryland State Highway Administration to install and maintain a traffic control device, sidewalk, and median at the intersection of MD 150 (Eastern Avenue) and the entrance to East Point Mall.

Background

This legislation will grant the Maryland State Highway Administration an easement over City infrastructure at this location in Baltimore County to support traffic signals.

Fiscal Impact

The Department of Finance anticipates minimal fiscal impact for the City from this legislation.

Conclusion

This legislation will grant a perpetual easement to the Maryland State Highway Administration to install and maintain a traffic control device, sidewalk, and median at the intersection of MD 150 (Eastern Avenue) and the entrance to East Point Mall. There is minimal fiscal impact anticipated from this legislation.
