INTRODUCTION – City Property - Naming the Baltimore City Health Department Building to the Dr. Maxie T. Collier Health Department Building

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of naming the Baltimore City Health Department Building, located at 1001 East Fayette Street, to the Dr. Maxie T. Collier Health Department Building.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 22-0198 looks to formally name the Baltimore City Health Department Headquarters, located at 1007 East Fayette Street, the Dr. Maxie T. Collier Health Department Building. Dr. Collier served as Baltimore City Health Commissioner from 1987 through 1990 and was the first African American to serve as the City's Health Commissioner. Dr. Collier is considered a pioneer in the world of public health, being an early advocate for sensible alternatives to the nation's longstanding approach to the sale of illicit drugs and drug addiction.

AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation foresees no direct operational or fiscal impact resulting from the advancement of the legislation and **supports** the advancement of Council Bill 22-0198.
