10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

14 **Subtitle 34. Commercial Vehicle Monitoring System**

15 **§ 34-3. Governing standards, etc.**

16 (b) *Maximum number of operational cameras.*

17 No more than [6] 16 cameras may be operational at any one time.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
19 after the date it is enacted.
