Subject: City Council Bill 22-0247

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 22-0247 introduced by Councilmembers Schleifer, Porter, Costello, Torrence, Glover, Stokes, Middleton, Conway, and Cohen.

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the obstruction of public streets for specified purposes; establishing certain penalties; and generally relating to obstructing a City street.

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City (PABC) has reviewed the proposed legislation. The PABC does not believe the proposed amendments, as drafted, will negatively impact any on-street parking programs under its administration.

Based on the comments above, the PABC does not oppose the passage of City Council Bill 22-0247.
