4	(Block 3448; Lot 030) and is no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in
12	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the Comptroller of Baltimore City may
13	sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in
14	the property located at 2001 Park Avenue (Block 3448; Lot 030), also known as the Brickhead
15	Estate, the Bond House, Mount Royal, Norse Hill Home, and the Norwegian Seaman's
16	Merchants Home, containing 1.835 acres, more or less, and improved by a 3 story building
17	containing 15,194 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.
18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
19	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
20	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
21	enacted.
