16 THERE IS A BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE HEAD OF WHICH IS THE POLICE
17 COMMISSIONER.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That this proposed amendment to the City
19 Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection,
20 in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the
21 City Solicitor.
