Permit 18DP2635, NPDES Permit MD0063924: Baltimore County Department of Public Works, Bureau of

Solid Waste Management, 111 W. Chesapeake Ave., Rm. 225, Towson, MD 21204 submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge an average of 14,891 gallons per day of treated leachate from the closed Hernwood Municipal Landfill, Northern Site, located at 10900 Furman Lane, Granite, MD, to an unnamed tributary of the North Branch Patapsco River (Use I waters). The Department is proposing to reissue the permit with limitations for BOD5 (10 mg/l

quarterly average, 15 mg/l daily maximum), total suspended solids (15 mg/l quarterly average, 30 mg/l daily maximum), total ammonia (summer - 1.43 mg/l quarterly average, 7.70 mg/l daily maximum and winter 2.65 mg/l quarterly average, 7.70 mg/l daily maximum), total volatile organic compounds (0.1 mg/l daily maximum), total zinc (0.11 mg/l quarterly average 0.12 mg/l daily maximum), al-pha terpineol (0.016 mg/l quarterly average, 0.033 mg/l daily maximum), benzoic acid (0.071 mg/l quarterly average, 0.12 mg/l daily maximum), p-cresol (0.014 mg/l quarterly average, 0.025 mg/l daily maximum), phenol (0.015 mg/l daily maximum) average, 0.026 mg/l daily maximum) and pH range (6.5 to 8.5). The permit includes monitoring for total iron and for total nitrogen loading. The permit also contains a new narrative condition for the use of sufficiently sensitive test methods, as well as an update for the testing of VOC's from EPA Method 621 to EPA Method 624.1. The permit application and

If a written request is received by August 9, 2022, a public hearing on the tentative determination for this application can be scheduled. Maryland Residents: You may qualify for assistance in paying your home telephone bill with a program known as Lifeline service. Lifeline is a

government assistance pro-gram that is offered in con-junction with the Maryland Public Service Commission and the Federal Communications Commission. Verizon Mary-land LLC offers the following Lifeline-supported services as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier: Basic Tel-Life Service is avail-
