<u>INTRODUCTION</u> - Repeal of Ordinances 07-609 and 09-139 - Westport Waterfront Planned Unit Development

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> - For the purpose of repealing Ordinance 07-609, which designated certain properties as a Business Planned Unit Development (PUD) known as Westport Waterfront; repealing Ordinance 09-139, which amended Ordinance 07-609; and providing for a special effective date.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 22-0189 seeks to abolish the Westport Waterfront PUD by way of repealing ordinance 07-609, through which the PUD was established in 2007. We defer to our colleagues at the Department of Planning and their recommendation that this bill moves forward. This transit-oriented development (per the original zoning designation of the lots within the PUD) will have convenient access to the region's mass transit through the Westport light rail station; the traffic burden of this project on City roads will likely be lessened as a result.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSTION</u> – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation has **no objection** to the advancement of Council Bill 22-0200.
