17 CANTON RAILROAD TRANSFER BRIDGE, IMPROVEMENT ONLY PARCEL: WARD 01,  
18 SECTION 10, BLOCK 1902-F, LOT 001.

19 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
20 after the date it is enacted.
