Re: City Council Bill 22-0252 – Commercial Vehicle Monitoring System

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 22-0252 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would increase the number of Commercial Vehicle Monitoring system cameras from 6 to 16.

The City is permitted to have vehicle height monitoring cameras under the authority and structure set forth in Section 24-111.3 of the Transportation Article of the Maryland Code. The increase in the number of cameras is not prohibited by the state law. Therefore, the Law Department can approve this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
