Dear Downtown Baltimore Community Organization Leaders & Members,

The Downtown Partnership is seeking an amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Central Business District to revise the signage provisions.

**City Council Bill No. 22-0200 is scheduled for a virtual public hearing at City Hall, Clarence “Du” Burns Chambers, 100 N. Holliday Street, 4th Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202 on November 1, 2022, at 2:00 PM.**

The purpose of City Council Bill No. 22-0200 is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for the Central Business District to revise the signage provisions; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of the Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.
