**REQUEST:** Review and Respond to City Council Bill #22-0279 - Urban Renewal – Coldstream Homestead Montebello- Amendment

**RECOMMENDATION**: CHAP has no objection to the amendment

### SITE/HISTORIC DISTRICT

The Coldstream Homestead Montebello neighborhood is located in northeast Baltimore, south of Lake Montebello and northwest of Clifton Park. A portion of the neighborhood was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2013. There are two Baltimore City Landmarks within the boundaries of the Urban Renewal Plan, the Friend's Burial Ground and Baltimore City College. The Olmsted Parkways Landmark runs along the north side of the neighborhood.

### **PROPOSAL**

The amendment was introduced for the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Coldstream Homestead Montebello to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

### **ANALYSIS**

CHAP staff finds that the proposed amendments will have no impact on designated historic properties as the amendments do not affect CHAP's design review authority in its local historic districts.
