11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the

15	(d) Deferred vested retirement benefit.		
16	(1) Eligibility.		
17	(i) First became member on or before December 5, 2016.		
18	An elected official who first became a member on or before December 5, 2016, is		
19	entitled to receive, commencing on the 1 st day of the month immediately		
20	following his or her 50 th birthday, a deferred vested retirement benefit, if the		
21	member has:		
22	(A) at least 12 years of service but less than 16 years of service;		
23	(B) left office before attaining age 50; and		
24	(C) after leaving office, elected not to withdraw his or her accumulated

27	An elected official who first became a member on or after December 6, 2016, OR,		
28	IS A MEMBER AND SERVING IN OFFICE AS OF DECEMBER 1, 2022, is entitled to

30	55 th birthday, a deferred vested retirement benefit, if the member has:

3	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That Section 1 of this Ordinance shall take
4	effect contingent on the ratification by the voters of the City at the 2022 general election of an
5	amendment to the City Charter that establishes a 2-term limit for Baltimore City elected officials,
6	including the Mayor, Comptroller, City Council President, and City Council members, wherein
7	none of the above-listed elected officials shall hold office for more than 8 years during any
8	12-year period.
9	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if an amendment to the City Charter that
10	establishes a 2-term limit for Baltimore City elected officials, including the Mayor, Comptroller,
11	City Council President, and City Council members, wherein none of the above listed elected
12	officials shall hold office for more than 8 years during any 12-year period is ratified at the 2022
13	general election, Section 1 of this Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2023.
