Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Councilmember Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and read the bill into the record.
- 2. Councilmember Cohen commented about the purpose of the bill and development in the Haven Street area. He expressed support for Port related industries. He explained that certain community groups support the bill.
- 3. Matt DeSantis presented the Planning Commission's report which supports the bill. Planning Department staff recommended disapproval, but based on information gathered at the department's hearing the Planning Commission issued a recommendation of support for the rezoning which included findings presented by the applicant's representative.
- 4. Liam Davis testified that the Department of Transportation has no objection, but indicated that the Statement of Intent indicated an inclusion of certain portions of land in the project.
- 5. Drew Tildon spoke on behalf of the applicant and presented information to support findings of facts.
- 6. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies.
- 7. The committee opened the hearing for public testimony.
- 8. The committee approved an amendment for the bill.
- 9. The committee approved a motion to recommend the bill favorably with amendment.
- 10. The hearing was adjourned.
