2. Energy Assistance Guidelines

Program eligibility is income based (federal poverty guidelines) and residents do not need a turn off notice to qualify for assistance.

- 1. Copy of Applicant's photo identification
- 2. Proof of Residency
- 3. Copies of Social Security cards for the entire household (including children)
- 4. Proof of your household's total Gross income for the last 30 day period
- 5. A copy of your most recent Utility bill, termination notice (if applicable)
- 6. A copy of your most recent heating fuel bill or receipt (if applicable)

Information Needed with Application: it is best to submit a completed application, submitting separately will delay application processing.

3. Rent Assistance Guidelines

Program eligibility is income based (must below 80% of AMI), additionally family must be able to demonstrate adverse impact by COVID-19.

Tenants

- 1. Income verification for all household members over 18 years of age
- 2. Photo ID for all household members over 18 years of age
- 3. COVID 19 impact statement
- 4. Landlord contact information
- 5. Signed lease

Landlords

- 1. Property license
- 2. Updated rent ledger
- 3. W9
- 4. Signed electronic funds transfer document along with voided check
