**INTRODUCTION** – Rezoning - 810 Leadenhall Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 810 Leadenhall Street (Block 0902, Lot 006), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the IMU-1 Zoning District to the TOD-4 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 22-0296 seeks authorization to rezone 810 Leadenhall Street from the IMU-1 Zoning District to the TOD-4 Zoning District. Per the City's Zoning Code, IMU-1 Districts permit a mixture of light industrial with residential and commercial uses. TOD-4 Zoning Districts allow for higher density, mixeduse development aimed at promoting the use of mass transit. The legislation's Statement of Intent indicates that the property owner intends to redevelop the property for multi-family residential purposes.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – Promoting transit use through transit-oriented development is aligned with BCDOT's Complete Streets efforts. Baltimore City DOT does not foresee an immediate operational or fiscal impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 22-0296.
