**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 28. Taxes**

**Subtitle 10. Credits**

**§ 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.**

(m) *Termination of program.*

Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after ~~February 28, [2023]~~  
2028 [February 28, 2023] AUGUST 28, 2024.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
enacted.
