7 City Council on the Housing Authority of Baltimore City's progress in furnishing broadband
8 internet access to low-income City residents through the Federal Emergency Broadband
9 Benefit program.

11 Council invites representatives from the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, the Department of
12 Housing and Community Development, Baltimore City Information Technology, the Department
13 of Recreation and Parks, and other interested parties to brief the City Council on the Housing
14 Authority of Baltimore City's progress in furnishing broadband internet access to low-income
15 City residents through the Federal Emergency Broadband Benefit program.

17 Executive Officer of the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, the Housing Commissioner of the
18 Department of Housing and Community Development, the Chief Information and Digital Officer
19 of Baltimore City Information Technology, the Director of the Department of Recreation and
20 Parks, and the Mayor's legislative liaison to the City Council.
